WEIGHT CLASSES: 101, 106, 111, 116, 121, 126, 131, 137, 143, 150, 160, 170, 189, 235
Scratch +2 (as long as wrestler has made scratch prior to this event)

TIMELINE FOR DISTRICTS (Trackwrestling.com):

Host teams window opens:	Friday, January 29
Assigned teams window opens:	Sunday, January 31
Teams can register backups:	Wednesday, February 3
Window closes:	Friday, February 5
Participant email with ticketing information:	Tuesday, February 9
Districts:	Sunday, February 14

WEIGHT: Wrestlers will get 2 pounds (ex. 101 = 103). Every wrestler MUST have made scratch weight prior to the event if she will utilize the 2 pound allowance. If she has NOT made scratch weight prior to the meet, she must do so on the first weigh in.

- a. Coaches must bring their team alpha and proof of your wrestler(s) weighing in at scratch weight (weigh in sheet signed by opposing coach and official)
- b. If an opposing coach wants to challenge a wrestler who they think may not have made scratch weight prior to the event, a formal request in writing (email) must be submitted to Dominic DiSabato (dominic_disabato@hboe.org) by Wednesday, Feb 10. Any challenges after this date will NOT be accepted.

QUALIFYING: *At least one coach per participating school must be a current member of the OHSWCA for their athlete to compete.*

Each competitor must be on the team's Alpha Roster and have completed the weight assessment. This State Meet follows all rules set by the OHSAA. Competing in this tournament DOES NOT count against tournament points for the wrestler/team (same as state duals).

REGISTRATION:

1. Track Wrestling.

 - b. Your school COUNTY dictates what District you are assigned to. Please be sure to register at the correct site or your athlete will go to the bottom of the list in your correct location

PAIRINGS:

Pairings will be posted by TBD on Track Wrestling-Harrison may use Flo for their tourney. Info tbd. Seeding criteria will be used at each site.

Girls District Seeding (based on girls matches **only**)

1. Returning state champ at same weight class
2. Returning state champ at different weight class
3. Returning state placer (2-6) at same weight class.
4. Returning state placer (2-6) at any weight class.
5. National level placement (Super 32, Fargo, etc.)
6. Current overall record against girls only (8-match minimum and .500 or better winning percentage). • If there is a tie in winning percentage the wrestler with the most wins will receive the higher seed. • If that does not break the tie, a coin-flip will determine the seed.
7. 2019-20 record v girls

Sunday, February 14, 2020

Weigh-ins suggested at 9 am with wrestling at 11 am. The event should take between 5.5 and 6.5 hours. EACH SITE CAN SET THEIR OWN TIMES

All 14 weights competing at same time

Host schools have freedom to adjust times according to their school district guidelines

Team personnel pass is needed for admittance, bullpen entrance and to sit matside. The event badge will allow entrance for both days.

Weigh Ins: 9:00 am Scratch + 2

We will follow the OHSAA procedures for skin check and weigh-ins for female wrestlers.

Please have qualifier passes for wrestlers at weigh-ins. Your wrestler will be stamped at the scale. All wrestlers will be present and remain in the designated area (Main Gym) by weight classes. Each weight will be escorted up to the scales in the wrestling room, located behind the bleachers in the main gym.

1. All OHSAA Skin Authorizations appropriately signed and dated must be present at weigh-ins
2. Weigh-ins will begin at 101 pounds and conclude at the end of the 235 pound weight class.
Wrestlers can step on and off the first scale 2 times, then if she still does not make weight, she can check the other scales one time

COACHES MEETING: To be determined by the host school

ALL WRESTLING TIMES ARE APPROXIMATE:

Sunday Feb 14, 2020:

Championship Round 1: 11 am

Wrestle until finals with breaks determined by host tourney director

Finals - 1st, 3rd place, 5th place (5th place will be the state alternate)

Awards: The Championship team and Runner-up team will be awarded a team trophy. No individual awards will be given

Entry Fee


1. \$38 per wrestler.
