Weight Classes will be Scratch +2

The GIRLS STATE TOURNAMENT will be a SPLIT EVENT. On Saturday, we will wrestle the first 7 weight classes through completion (101-131) and on Sunday we will wrestle the second 7 weight classes from 137-235. Your girls will NOT be able to attend the event on the day they are not wrestling. Please make arrangements for this.

In order to prevent the 5 match rule from being an issue, the losers of the championship semifinals will wrestle for 3rd place and the winners will wrestle for the championship. The consolation bracket will determine the 5th-6th place medalists.

Qualifying: At least one coach per participating school must be a current member of the OHSWCA for their athlete to compete.

There will be 4 district qualifying meets. Your school is assigned to a district based on the county this school address is in. All competitors must be members of their OHSAA school team in order to be eligible to compete.

Each competitor must be on the team's Alpha Roster and have completed the weight assessment. This State Meet follows all rules set by the OHSAA. Competing in this tournament DOES NOT count against tournament points for the wrestler/team (same as state duals).

Doors will open for coaches and wrestlers at 8:00 am. Enter through the main doors on Avery Road.

Check In: 8:00 am - 9:00 am

Coaches report to the fieldhouse for check-in procedures

You will receive the following:

1. 1 pass per competitor
2. Wristbands for coaches
 - a. 1 wrestlers - 1 pass
 - b. 2 wrestlers - 2 passes
 - c. 3-9 wrestlers - 3 passes
 - d. 10 or more - 4 passes
3. No passes for stats, trainers, bus drivers etc

***Team personnel pass is needed for admittance, bullpen entrance and to sit matside. The event badge will allow entrance for both days.**

Weigh Ins: 9:00 am Scratch + 2 We will follow the OHSAA procedures for skin check and weigh ins for female wrestlers.

Please have qualifier passes for wrestlers at weigh-ins. Your wrestler will be stamped at the scale. All wrestlers will be present and remain in the designated area (Main Gym) by weight classes. Each weight will be escorted up to the scales in the wrestling room, located behind the bleachers in the main gym.

1. All OHSAA Skin Authorizations appropriately signed and dated must be present at weigh-ins

2. Weigh-ins will begin at 101 pounds and conclude at the end of the 131 pound weight class on Saturday and 137-235 for Sunday. Wrestlers can step on and off the first scale 2 times, then if she still does not make weight, she can check the other scales one time

TEAM MEALS: HCSD has asked that we do not set up TEAM MEALS areas. Please have your athletes pack individual coolers for the day. Athletes should practice social distancing while eating

Awards: Will be handed out at the conclusion of 131 pound weight class and 235 pound weight class on perspective dates to the top 6 places.

The Championship team and Runner-up team will be awarded a team trophy.

- Teams that are in the running for a team title will be allowed to have their competitors from Saturday attend the finals along with their parents. Details still being worked out.

UPDATES AS OF 02.16.21

We are unable to have more coaches than listed above. We have a limit on capacity in the gym. We know it is not ideal, but it is the number we had to have to be able to host this event. If you do **not** have a wrestler competing on a certain day, please do not come to the event. (for example, Davidson has 1 wrestler at 160. The pass is only good for Sunday. If your wrestler competes on Saturday only, please do not come Sunday)

We will have updated guidelines for numbers in the gym and fieldhouse. This event will run smoothly as long as coaches and wrestlers cooperate. The last thing we need is to be shut down during Day 1 and not have Day 2.

There will be NO stats, videographer, bus drivers, or anyone else admitted. I am looking into Administrators that want to attend. We have a limit of fans in the stands, and since we are allowing 2 parents per kid, we have very few spots left. I'm sure you all can understand this.

Tickets will be through Hometownticketing.com. Each wrestler will get an email with a code to order tickets.

Alternates can attend weigh-ins and stay, but no parents unless wrestling.

We will make a decision on teams competing for a trophy and who will be allowed to come back for the finals.

Alternates:

1. If your district had a 5th place finisher, that wrestler is your district alternate.
2. If you had no 5th place finisher, then your district has no alternate.
 - a. If a wrestler from a district with only 4 placers cannot compete, we will draw a pill to name an alternate from the other districts .
